

Description Freeman 23 - Miss Moneypenny



This is another good example of the renowned boat builder John Freeman's excellent craftsmanship. Last year she had all the exterior woodwork stripped and varnished. She has also been re-fitted in the cabin area 4 years ago which included new cushions in the sleeping area / forward cabin and saloon area too. She was also fitted with a pump out toilet connected to a waste tank which is located under the floor in the wheel house. There is also a shower from which you can get hot or cold water. Both are located in the same area which is the original cupboard designed for a portable toilet. It is a tight squeeze if you are an adult male but it works perfectly for women and children!

She also has hot and cold water to prepare food and wash up with. The hot water for both the shower and sink comes from the chlorifier which is fitted in the stern of the boat and is heated by the engine water. The cooker is calor gas connected to a gas bottle located in the gas locker also located at the stern of the boat. Domestic power comes from a second 12 volt battery.

The engine is 55 hp petrol serviced by Lindon Lewis Marine and myself and is in good working order. She has never let me down on trips! Also fitted are two exhaust silencers and sound proofing around the engine housing to make sitting in the wheel house area quieter. The boat canopy is five years old and was purchased from Sheridan Marine.

Hull is in very good condition for a 32 year old boat partly because she was out of the water for 10 years. When out of the water in May 2006 she was treated for 5 osmosis bubbles.

Anti fouling will be carried out this year and also the renewal of the Boat Safety Certificate before she goes back in the water in at the end of March. Miss Moneypenny is moored at Tadpole Bridge, Oxfordshire.
